



Water Policy – Australia

Water is a very precious resource; essential for life and wellbeing. Coca-Cola Amatil (CCA) Australia uses water from metropolitan supplies for our beverage and food production and from natural groundwater sources for our water bottling business.

CCA has a role to play in the management of Australia's water sources and we aim to lead industry by our actions. Water is vital to our business and we will use it in a responsible and sustainable manner.

To this end, we will:

- Through our Environmental Management System, continuously improve efficiency of water use in our production facilities;
- Maintain site management plans in accordance with our Quality and Environmental Management Systems for mineral water sources, taking into consideration the hydrogeological aspects of each source, their zones of influence, sustainability and use;
- Maintain open dialogue with governments, non-government organisations and local communities about water resource management;
- Confirm the sustainability of a source prior to it being used for any mineral water for CCA products; and
- Only alter water extraction limits when independent assessment shows that this will not jeopardise the quality of the water extracted and the sustainability of the source.
